PLAN DE CLASES

CLASS 1. Theory

Marathon Method: Introduction to the *Marathon for fluency* method. Method objectives and grading system. Introduction to Marathon 1.

Grammar Core Method: Introduction to the *Grammar Core for Accuracy Method*. Rule 1: Word Order. Personal and Possessive Pronouns.

Vocabulary: Introductions: professions, marital status, family, leisure-time activities, movie genres, transportation, cultural places, likes and dislikes, neighborhood places. Verbs for routines. Numbers 1-20, 20-1,000. Alphabet.

Speaking Forum: Student's introduction audio.

CLASS 2. Practice on Class 1

Live Chat #1. Objectives: to meet, clarify doubts on methods, Marathon practice and feedback.

Activities: Marathon 1 student's audio/video, Speaking forum on the neighborhood, interactive grammar exercises on Word Order.

CLASS 3. Theory

Marathon Method: review of Marathon 1 and introduction to Marathon 2.

Grammar Core Method: Rule 2: Time Zones and Tenses. Tense: Simple Present. Keywords and Exchanges in Simple Present.

CLASS 4. Practice on Class 3

Live Chat #2. Objectives: practice Marathons 1 and 2, get instant feedback, solve method and grammar doubts.

Activities: student's Marathon 2 audio/video, Speaking forum on Exchanges in Simple Present, interactive grammar exercises on Simple Present.

CLASS 5. Theory and Practice

Marathon Method: review on Marathon 2, introduction to Marathon 3.

Grammar Core Method: Rule 2: Tense: Present Continuous. Keywords and Exchanges in Present Continuous.

Activities: Marathons 1 and 2 audios/videos, Speaking forum, interactive grammar exercises.

CLASS 6. **Review:** Marathons 1, 2, and 3, and all Grammar topics.

CLASS 7. **Final Marathon Exam** (video), **Final Grammar Exam** (integrative exercise), and **Final Speaking Exam** (audio integrating Marathon Method and Grammar Core Method).

CLASS 8: Results, feedback, and next steps will be emailed to each student.

Certifications to approved students will be emailed two weeks after the course has been completed.
